

Sutton Lake Marina

Location and Directions:

Location: Sutton Lake Marina is located at the Bee Run Recreation Area on Sutton Lake. The Lake is in Braxton County, West Virginia. Geographically in the center of the State, Braxton County was formed in 1835 from parts of Lewis, Kanawha, and Nicholas counties and named for Carter Braxton, a Virginia statesman and signer of the Declaration of Independence. The county seat is Sutton.

The marina is just a few minutes from Interstate 79. The Lake is an easy day's drive from most of the lower East Coast and Mid Atlantic States. By way of example:

- Washington, DC - 4.5 Hours
- Pittsburgh, PA- 3.0 Hours
- Charlotte, NC- 5.0 Hours
- Richmond, VA- 5.5 Hours
- Cincinnati, OH- 4.7 Hours

Directions: From the Flatwoods exit of I-79 (exit 67) head south on Route 19 and 4 toward the town of Sutton. Pass the high school and turn left on Route 15. There is a convenience store on the corner. Proceed about 2 miles to the entrance to Bee Run on the right. Follow the access road to the lake and the marina.
